

**ORDINANCE NO. 1016**

**ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF BARRINGTON, COUNTY OF CAMDEN,  
STATE OF NEW JERSEY AMENDING CHAPTER 120, VEHICLES AND  
TRAFFIC, OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF BARRINGTON**

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of Barrington, County of Camden, and State of New Jersey that Section 120, Vehicles and Traffic, is hereby added in the Code of the Borough of Barrington, as follows:

**ARTICLE I. ARTICLE VIII. SECTION 120-28 Schedule VII: Stop Intersections.**

In accordance with Section 120-11, the following locations are added as stop intersections:

Second Avenue and Haines Avenue	Second Avenue
Second Avenue and Haines Avenue	Haines Avenue

**ARTICLE II.**

All Ordinances contrary to the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent that they are inconsistent herewith.

**ARTICLE III.**

This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication according to law.

**WHEREAS**, the Borough Council has applied for funding to the Governor's Council on Alcoholism and Drug Abuse through the County of Camden;


