

## BARRINGTON LOST WORLD DOG PARK RULES AND REGULATIONS PER ORDINANCE NO. 918

- 1. Lost World Dog Park off-leash area is for use by permit only with valid ID card.
- 2. Dog Park hours are from dawn to dusk and may be closed or adjusted as conditions require.
- 3. Maximum of two dogs per adult at once inside the dog park. When others are waiting, please limit your use to thirty (30) minutes. The maximum number of dogs at one time is twenty (20).
- 4. Dogs must be leashed prior to entering and upon leaving the Dog Park. Owners must remain with their dogs at all times and must carry a leash for each dog.
- 5. All responsible persons shall, at all times, clean up after dogs and dispose of waste in an appropriate container.
- 6. Adults must maintain control over dogs at all times and must immediately remove threatening or aggressive dogs. "Mounting" shall be cause for the removal of the dog from the Dog Park.
- 7. Any dog over the age of four (4) months must be healthy, vaccinated, legally licensed and wearing ID tags prior to use of any dog exercise area.
- 8. Dogs under the age of four (4) months are prohibited from the Dog Park.
- 9. Female dogs in heat are not permitted in any dog exercise area.
- 10. No food or food products are allowed, whether intended for human or dog consumption.
- 11. While inside the Dog Park boundaries, an adult must accompany minors under the age of fifteen (15). Children under the age of eight (8) are not permitted in the Dog Park.
- Gates must remain closed at all times.
- 13. All rules governing Borough parks and recreation areas and relevant parking regulations apply.
