



ORDINANCE NO. 1111

ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF BARRINGTON, COUNTY OF CAMDEN AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY REPEALING ORDINANCE 948, WHICH REMOVED THE STOP INTERSECTION AT RUSSELL AND ADAMS AVENUES

ARTICLE I.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Barrington, County of Camden, and State of New Jersey, that Ordinance 948, which amended Chapter 120, Section 120-11, and Schedule VII, Stop Intersections, and removed the stop intersection at Russell and Adams Avenues, is hereby repealed in its entirety.

ARTICLE II.

All Ordinances contrary to the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent that they are inconsistent herewith.

ARTICLE III.

This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication according to law.

RESOLUTION 7-2019-70

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING EMERGENCY CLEANING AND TELEVISIONING OF THE STORM DRAINAGE PIPING SYSTEM IN VARIOUS LOCATIONS AND EMERGENCY REPAIRS TO THE SANITARY SEWER PIPES ALONG LAWRENCE AVENUE IN THE BOROUGH OF BARRINGTON

WHEREAS, on June 20, 2019 the Borough of Barrington received approximately 5 inches of rainfall in approximately 3.5 hours; and

WHEREAS, the storm drainage piping systems within the Borough of Barrington, State of New Jersey and County of Camden were unable to properly convey the runoff resulting in severe flooding in several areas throughout the Borough of Barrington; and

WHEREAS, upon investigation by the Barrington Public Works Department, Borough Official's and the Borough Engineer's Office, it was determined that there was significant damage to properties, individual belongings and motor vehicles; and

WHEREAS, upon further investigation by the Barrington Public Works Department, Borough Official's and the Borough Engineer's Office it was determined that many of the storm drainage piping systems became inundated with silt and debris; and

WHEREAS, the clogged condition of the storm drainage piping and potential for continued flash flooding of the properties and streets to occur as a result of the condition is considered a life safety hazard, as well as a potential health hazard and therefore must be resolved immediately; and

WHEREAS, the Barrington Borough Engineer and the Superintendent of the Barrington Public Works Department evaluated the situation and determined that the emergency storm drainage piping system cleaning and televising is necessary to avoid said life safety issues and potential health hazards; and

WHEREAS, Root 24, Inc. of Camden, New Jersey has been contracted under an emergency condition to clean and televising the storm drainage piping system in various locations throughout the Borough of Barrington in the presence of the Public Works Sewer Department; and

WHEREAS, in addition to the situation with the storm drainage system, the excessive rain fall also caused a force main break of the sanitary sewer pipes along Lawrence Avenue; and

WHEREAS, Pioneer Pipe Contractors, Inc., had to be called in to make an emergency repair to the sanitary sewer pipes along Lawrence Avenue and the roadway will need to be repaved; and

WHEREAS, that such emergencies affect the public health, safety and welfare of the Borough of Barrington and must be dealt with as soon as practically possible;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Barrington, County of Camden, and State of New Jersey in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40A:11-6, a Contract was awarded to Root 24, Inc. of Camden, New Jersey for the emergency televising and cleaning the storm drainage piping system in various locations throughout the Borough of Barrington; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a contract was awarded to Pioneer Pipe Contractors, Inc., for the emergency repairs to the sanitary sewer pipes along Lawrence Avenue; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the total cost for both of these emergency repairs is approximately \$60,000.00 and shall be charged to the Sewer Utility Fund.

AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITH THE AMERICAN RED CROSS
