NEW PROGRAM

Temporary Relief for Utility Expenses (TRUE)

The TRUE program is a one-time assistance program that may help low-to-moderate income households experiencing economic hardship and struggling to pay their PSE&G bills.

PSE&G customer can receive a one-time TRUE grant of up to \$1,500 towards their PSE&G bill. The maximum grant is \$750 for electric and \$750 for gas service, depending on your balance owed. Funds will be allocated on a first come, first serve basis.

To be eligible you must:

- ❖ Have an electric and/or gas account that is currently 45 days or more past due.
- ❖ Not have their electric and/or gas service disconnected.
- ❖ Have made at least four payments of \$25 or more in the last six months.
- ❖ Not have received LIHEAP of USF in the last year
- ❖ Meet the true grant annual income requirements listed in the chart below.


