

**ORDINANCE 974
AMENDING CHAPTER 91, PEACE AND GOOD ORDER,
OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF BARRINGTON**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of Barrington, County of Camden, and State of New Jersey that Article II. is amended in Chapter 91, Peace and Good Order, of the Code of the Borough of Barrington, as follows:

**ARTICLE II.
Obstruction of Public Ways and Places**

ARTICLE I. ARTICLE II. SECTION 91-13 Definitions.

As used in this Article, the following terms shall have meanings indicated:

LOITERING – Deleted in its entirety.

PUBLIC PLACES – Retained in its entirety.

ARTICLE II. ARTICLE II. SECTION 91-14 Obstruction of Public Ways and Places

A. It shall be unlawful for any person to:
