

ORDINANCE NO. 1017

CALENDAR YEAR 2014 ORDINANCE TO EXCEED THE MUNICIPAL BUDGET APPROPRIATION LIMITS AND TO ESTABLISH A CAP BANK (N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-45.14)

WHEREAS, the Local Government Cap Law, N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-45.14 et seq., provides that in the preparation of its annual budget, a municipality shall limit any increase in said budget to .5% unless authorized by ordinance to increase it to 3.5% over the previous year's final appropriations, subject to certain exceptions; and,

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-45.15a provides that a municipality may, when authorized by ordinance, appropriate the difference between the amount of its actual final appropriation and the 3.5% percentage rate as an exception to its final appropriations in either of the next two succeeding years; and,

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the Borough of Barrington in the County of Camden finds it advisable and necessary to increase its CY 2014 budget by up to 3.5% over the previous year's final appropriations, in the interest of promoting the health, safety and welfare of the citizens; and,

WHEREAS, the Governing Body hereby determines that a 3.0% increase in the budget for said year, amounting to \$158,118.93 in excess of the increase in final appropriations otherwise permitted by the Local Government Cap Law, is advisable and necessary; and,

WHEREAS, the Governing Body hereby determines that any amount authorized hereinabove that is not appropriated as part of the final budget shall be retained as an exception to final appropriation in either of the next two succeeding years;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Governing Body of the Borough of Barrington, in the County of Camden, a majority of the full authorized membership of this governing body affirmatively concurring, that, in the CY 2014 budget year, the final appropriations of the Barrington shall, in accordance with this ordinance and N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-45.14, be increased by 3.5 %, amounting to \$184,472.08 and that the CY 2014 municipal budget for the Barrington be approved and adopted in accordance with this ordinance; and,

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that any that any amount authorized hereinabove that is not appropriated as part of the final budget shall be retained as an exception to final appropriation in either of the next two succeeding years; and,

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that a certified copy of this ordinance as introduced be filed with the Director of the Division of Local Government Services within five days of introduction; and,

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that a certified copy of this ordinance upon adoption, with the recorded vote included thereon, shall be filed with said Director within five days after such adoption.

RESOLUTION NO. 4-2014-34

AUTHORIZING SUBMISSION OF APPLICATION FOR TONNAGE GRANT

WHEREAS, the Mandatory Source Separation and Recycling Act, P.L.1987, c.102, has established a recycling fund from which tonnage grants may be made to municipalities in order to encourage local source separation and recycling programs; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent and the spirit of the mandatory Source Separation and Recycling Act to use the tonnage grants to develop new municipal recycling programs and to continue and to expand existing programs; and

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection has promulgated recycling regulations to implement the Mandatory Source Separation and Recycling Act; and

WHEREAS, the recycling regulations impose on municipalities certain requirements as a condition for applying for tonnage grants, including but not limited to, making and keeping accurate, verifiable records of materials collected and claimed by the municipality; and

WHEREAS, a resolution authorizing this municipality to apply for the 2013 Recycling Tonnage Grant will memorialize the commitment of this municipality to recycling and to indicate the assent of Mayor and Council of the Borough of Barrington to the efforts undertaken by the municipality and the requirements contained in the Recycling Act and recycling regulations; and

WHEREAS, such a resolution should designate the individual authorized to ensure the application is properly completed and timely filed.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Barrington that the Borough of Barrington hereby endorses the submission of the recycling tonnage grant application to the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection and designates Michael J. Ciocco, Superintendent of Public Works, to ensure that the application is properly filed; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the monies received from the recycling tonnage grant be deposited in a dedicated recycling trust fund to be used solely for the purposes of recycling.

AUTHORIZING TEMPORARY EMERGENCY APPROPRIATIONS

WHEREAS, adoption of the 2014 Municipal Budget has been delayed pending additional review of the Operating Budget and the proposed increase to the tax rate; and

WHEREAS, no provision was made in the 2014 Temporary Budget for budget appropriations beyond March 31, 2014; and

WHEREAS, NJSA 40A:4-20 provides for the creation of an emergency temporary appropriation for operating expenditures when the adoption of the Municipal Budget has been delayed; and

WHEREAS, the total emergency operating expenditures for the second quarter of 2014 are expected to be \$ 1,564,391.76 for the Current Fund and \$ 152,882.46 for the Sewer Fund;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Barrington in accordance with the provisions of NJSA 40A:4-20 that:

1. An emergency temporary appropriation in the amount of \$ 1,564,391.76 for the Current Fund and \$ 152,882.46 for the Sewer Fund is hereby made.
2. That said emergency temporary appropriations have been provided for in the 2014 Municipal Budget.

RESOLUTION NO. 4-2014-37

RESOLUTION TO USE ALTERNATE TAX COLLECTION RATE PURSUANT TO N.J.S.A. 40A:4-41 FOR USE IN THE 2014 MUNICIPAL BUDGET

WHEREAS, the Borough of Barrington experienced substantial cancellations of 2013 property taxes due to tax appeal judgments of the Camden County Tax Board pursuant to R.S.54:3-21 et seq., or the State Tax Court pursuant to R.S.54:48-1 et seq., and a resulting decline in the tax collection rate for the year 2013; and

WHEREAS, the use of the lower collection rate in arriving at the budget appropriation Reserve for Uncollected Taxes in the 2014 Municipal Budget would result in an unfair tax burden to the taxpayers of the Borough of Barrington; and

WHEREAS, if tax appeal judgments of the County Tax Board or the State Tax Court result in tax reductions for the previous fiscal year, the governing body of the municipality may elect to calculate the current year Reserve for Uncollected Taxes by reducing the certified tax levy of the prior year by the amount of the adjustments resulting from those judgments; and

WHEREAS, the Division of Local Government Services, Department of Community Affairs will allow the Borough of Barrington to use the alternate collection rate for the year 2013 in calculating the budget appropriation Reserve for Uncollected Taxes in the 2014 Municipal Budget; and

WHEREAS, the prior year's collection rate without reducing the certified tax for County Tax Board or the State Tax Court appeals is 97.86%; and

WHEREAS, the prior year's collection rate with reducing the certified tax for County Tax Board or the State Tax Court appeals is 94.79%.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council that the Borough of Barrington will use the collection rate of 97.86% in calculating the budget appropriation Reserve for Uncollected Taxes in the 2014 Municipal Budget.
