

**ORDINANCE NO. 1018**

**FIXING THE 2014 COMPENSATION OF CERTAIN OFFICERS AND  
EMPLOYEES OF THE BOROUGH OF BARRINGTON**

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Borough Council of the Borough of Barrington as follows:

**SECTION 1.** The following are the maximum annual base salaries to be paid to the respective employees and officers of the Borough of Barrington, County of Camden, State of New Jersey, while in the employ of the Borough of Barrington effective January 1, 2014, unless otherwise noted:

Chief of Police	\$ 106,500
Sup't. of Public Works	\$ 80,719
Foreman of Public Works	\$ 63,724
Municipal Clerk <sup>1</sup>	\$ 57,506
Finance Officer <sup>2</sup>	\$ 57,447

Secretary to Mayor and Council /AP Clerk	\$ 43,905

The above wages will be divided by 52 to determine the weekly amount.

**SECTION 2.** Wages to be paid to persons performing any other work except as described herein, and which employee or officer is not covered by a union contract, shall be paid the sum of minimum wage to \$10.00 per hour, with time and one-half for overtime when approved by the department head.

**SECTION 3.** Wages to be paid to the following part-time employees are fixed at the indicated hourly rates EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2014:

**SECTION 5.** Compensation for the following positions and/or services shall be at the rates as indicated below effective January 1, 2014, unless otherwise indicated:

Resale Inspector	35.00 per inspection

Part Time Fire Alliance Inspector	100.00/day
VFW Maintenance/Security	100.00 per event worked

**SECTION 6.** Longevity will be added to the base salary for all non-union, full-time employees hired before 1/1/96, based upon the following schedule:

- Beginning of 6<sup>th</sup> year through the 10<sup>th</sup> year – 3%
- Beginning of 11<sup>th</sup> year through the 15<sup>th</sup> year – 6%
- Beginning of 16<sup>th</sup> year through end of employment – 8%

**SECTION 7.** The compensation herein specified shall take effect as indicated, and shall apply thereto unless and until, the same have been changed as provided by law.

**SECTION 8.** All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed, but only to the extent of such inconsistency.

**SECTION 9.** This Ordinance shall take effect upon its enactment as provided by law.

<sup>1</sup> The \$57,506.00 salary shown for the Municipal Clerk is based on a 35 hour week, 52 weeks per year while performing the duties of Municipal Clerk for the Borough of Barrington. This position is part of a shared service with the Borough of Mount Ephraim. The additional salary for the Mount Ephraim position is \$14,848.00. Should the shared service be dissolved, that additional salary shall end as of the termination date of the Shared Service Agreement.

<sup>2</sup> The \$57,447.00 salary shown for the Finance Officer is based on a 35 hour week, 52 weeks per year while performing the duties of Finance Officer for the Borough of Barrington. This position is part of a shared service with the Borough of Merchantville. The additional salary for the Merchantville position is \$26,700.00. Should the shared service be dissolved, the additional salary shall end as of the termination date of the Shared Service Agreement.

<sup>3</sup> The \$52,977.00 salary shown for the Tax Collector/Sewer Rent Collector is based on a 35 hour week, 52 weeks per year while performing the duties of Tax Collector/Sewer Rent Collector for the Borough of Barrington. This position is part of a shared service with the Borough of Merchantville as Tax Collector and the Borough of Runnemede as Payroll Clerk. The additional salary for the Merchantville position is \$16,000.00 and the additional salary for the Runnemede position is \$10,500.00. The combined total salary is \$79,477.00. Should either shared service be dissolved, that additional annual salary shall end as of the termination date of the relevant Shared Service Agreement.

**PROVIDING FOR PURCHASE OF AMBULANCE FROM THE BOROUGH OF  
HADDON HEIGHTS AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND BOROUGH  
CLERK TO EXECUTE ALL DOCUMENTS NECESSARY TO  
EFFECTUATE SALE**

**WHEREAS**, the Borough of Haddon Heights (hereinafter, "Haddon Heights") is the current owner of a 2007 Ford Van (VIN 1FDXE45897DA64386) last used within the Borough of Haddon Heights in or about 2012 as an ambulance vehicle; and

**WHEREAS**, Haddon Heights does not require the aforesaid vehicle as it has entered into a Shared Services Agreement with the Borough of Barrington (hereinafter, "Barrington") to provide ambulance service to Haddon Heights residents and it appears that the Shared Services Agreement continues to serve the interests of Haddon Heights and Barrington, respectively; and

**WHEREAS**, Barrington has expressed an interest to purchase the aforesaid vehicle upon terms and conditions which will provide for payment of cash to Haddon Heights in the sum of Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000.00). In addition thereto, Barrington and the Barrington Ambulance Association will extend the Shared Services Agreement with Haddon Heights through calendar year 2018, and will provide that Haddon Heights will not pay for ambulance service for the years 2014, 2015 and 2016. The sum otherwise payable would be Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00) per year for the years 2014, 2015 and 2016; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:12-13(b), personal property of a public entity may be sold privately to any political subdivision, agency, department, commission, board or body corporate and politic of the State of New Jersey; and

**WHEREAS**, Barrington, as a body politic and municipal corporation of the State of New Jersey, satisfies the terms of N.J.S.A. 40A:12-13(b).

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED**, by the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of Barrington, that the purchase of a 2007 Ford Van (VIN 1FDXE45897DA64386) currently titled to the Borough of Haddon Heights be and hereby is approved, upon the terms and amounts as hereinabove set forth; and

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** that Robert Klaus, Mayor of the Borough of Barrington and Terry Shannon, Borough Clerk of the Borough of Barrington, be and hereby are authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to facilitate the purchase of the aforesaid personal property from the Borough of Haddon Heights, upon the terms and for the amounts hereinabove noted; and

**BE IT FURHTER ORDAINED** that all Ordinances contrary to the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent that they are inconsistent herewith; and that this Ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication according to law.
