

**BOROUGH OF BARRINGTON MINUTES OF SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING  
MARCH 28, 2017, 6:15PM, MAYOR/COUNCIL CHAMBERS**

A Special Meeting of the Borough of Barrington was held on March 28, 2017, at 6:15pm in Council Chambers at the Barrington Municipal Building, with Council President Popiolek presiding.

**CALL TO ORDER:** Council President Popiolek called the meeting to order and made the following statement: "This special meeting is held in compliance with Chapter 231 of the open public meetings act of 1975 and appropriate notice has been given. Notice of the meeting was filed with the Retrospect and Courier Post and also in the main office of the Borough Clerk where notices are primarily kept. He then led the salute to the flag of our country.

**ROLL CALL:** The Municipal Clerk called roll of Council and reports the following:

Clerk Shannon announced that the following ordinance is on this agenda for introduction on first reading and that it deletes line number 4 from section H of the sign ordinance which restricts colors. She then read the ordinance by title as:

Ord. 1071 Amending Chapter 129, Zoning, Signs, in the Borough Code

On a motion by Councilman Beach, second by Councilwoman Harris, the first reading of Ordinance 1071 was approved with the following poll vote: Popiolek-yes; Beach-yes; Fawley-yes; Harris-yes; Ludwig-yes; Robenolt-yes.

Council President Popiolek announced that this ordinance will be considered for adoption following a public hearing at the April 11 council meeting.

Clerk Shannon then announced that Sharon Beach had received donations from vendors for the basket auction and we issued a check to her to use the funds to purchase items for the baskets. We need to approve the advance by resolution as follows:

On a motion by Councilwoman Harris, second by Councilwoman Fawley, the resolution was approved with the following poll vote: Popiolek-yes; Beach-abstain Fawley-yes; Harris-yes; Ludwig-yes; Robenolt-yes.

On a motion by Councilman Ludwig, second by Councilman Robenolt, the public portion of the special meeting was opened. Seeing no public in attendance, on a motion by Councilwoman Harris, second by Councilman Ludwig, the public portion of the meeting was closed.

Seeing no further business to be transacted, on a motion by Councilman Ludwig, second by Councilman Beach, the meeting was adjourned at 6:20pm.
