◆Review of Engineer's Report

- ♦Town wide yard sale—this weekend, October 10. Already have 30 homes registered.
- ♦Pet licensing—rabies clinic was held this past weekend. Only 25 animals were immunized. We will be sending out final reminders to register pets by October 31 or late fee will be added.
- ♦Paving of Clements Bridge Road—will begin on Wednesday. Alternating single lanes of traffic—no detour. Expect to be finished by middle of next week.
- ◆Election information—all information pertaining to the election is on the website. I am getting a lot of calls from voters who plan to bring their ballots to the polls on Election Day. It will be very busy.
- ♦Municipal resolution regarding transport of LNG—provided by a resident who will be on the Zoom meeting.
- ♦Meeting format—some towns are going to a hybrid format for meetings that includes in-person and Zoom so participants can make their own decision as to how they want participate. Do you want to consider hybrid meetings or stay with an electronic format?
- ◆Halloween trick or treating—what hours would you like to establish for trick-or-treating?
- New rules regarding electronic meetings—Local Finance Notice 2020-21 establishes new rules for remote meetings. We are already in compliance with most but do have to make some changes. Tim and I are working on protocols and will have a resolution ready for the November caucus meeting. A summary of the regulations was prepared by the MEL and is attached for your review.
- ♦Address situation on Clements Bridge Road—we have an issue with the two properties in Haddon Heights (Barrington Diner and the Antique Shop) and their address that we are trying to get resolved with Haddon Heights. The diner is 527 and the antique shop is 531. The properties across the street

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are 28, 30 and 32. The problem is we have a residents at 527 Clements Bridge Road so we have two properties with the same address. The property owner is not getting his mail and his Amazon packages are being delivered to the diner. Brian reached out to the HH assessor but has not heard back. We are asking them to drop the "5" and change the addresses to 27 and 31 respectively which would be in line with the properties across the street.
