# Administration:

- ◆Election information—official certificates from the Board of Canvassers were received. Congratulations to Councilman Drumm, Councilman Cerrito and Councilman Hanson.
- ◆Resolution setting Reorg and January meetings—Reorganization will be Sunday, January 3 and will be held via Zoom. The January Zoom meetings will be January 5 for caucus & January 12 for council.
- ◆Shredding event—we will be holding a shredding event for residents this Saturday, December 5 from 9am-12 noon in Borough Hall parking lot. We will be destroying a lot of borough records that qualify for destruction and have been approved by the auditor and the state. Thanks to Denise, Megan and Eileen for going through the records and preparing them for destruction.
- ◆Renewal of contract with Homeward Bound for animal shelter services—the contract for 2020 was \$600 per month and they raised the fees for 2021 to \$625 per month. We did not have an increase in the number of animals—they raised their fees because of an increase in their operating costs.
- ♦Grant award from DOT—we were awarded \$225.000 from DOT Municipal Aid for the reconstruction of Austin Avenue. The engineer will prepare the plans for this project for bidding in 2021.
- ◆Renewal of contract with animal control officer—Independent Animal Control submitted his renewal contract for 2021 and there is no increase. He will continue to charge \$500 per month.
- ◆Authorizing renewal of shared service agreement with Oaklyn for court services—new agreement is attached. We are moving to a fixed cost that will be paid quarterly. This is a three-year agreement.
- Authorizing renewal of SSA with Mount Ephraim for clerk services—Mount Ephraim has approved so resolution will be on the agenda.
- Fair and Open selection of professionals—RFQ packages are due back on December 11. I will send you a report of respondents and submittal packages will be in council office for your review.

- ♦Shared service agreement with Gloucester City for purchase of brine—Mike wants to renew this agreement so resolution will be on the agenda. \$.46 per gallon.
