Administration:

- ◆Ballot Drop-Box—the Board of Elections installed the ballot drop-box ahead of schedule and it is in the parking lot. It will be in use for the November election.
- ◆Cyber Security Requirements—the MEL and JIF have made substantial changes to the required personnel policies and the cyber security requirements for all members. We are in the process of incorporating the personnel policy language requirements into our policies and will have it ready for your review for the next meeting. Regarding the Cyber Security Policies, Denise and I met with E3 IT to review the plans for compliance. They are very familiar with the requirements and understand municipal needs and our software packages. They submitted the cost proposal for the required upgrades to bring us into compliance with the new requirements. The proposal is attached and will cost an additional \$713 per month for monitoring, training, testing and reporting. In addition to making us fully compliant with the JIF requirements, this will also increase our level of cyber security. The new JIF requirements also apply to police department and fire department systems IT systems.
- ◆Employee Assistance Program—Cooper has an employee assistance program that is geared towards first responders but is also available to other employees as well. The way the program works is if an employee is having difficulty coping, they can go to the program and the first six sessions are free. After those six sessions, if the therapist determines that the employee needs further assistance, they will refer them to a therapist that is in the employee's healthcare network. This is especially valuable to anyone dealing with PTSD because of a work incident. The cost of this program is \$3500 annually which covers up to 50 employees. We are recommending that we sign-up with this program. If approved, a resolution to participate will be on the agenda. Information about the program is attached.

◆Codification project—the review of the manuscript provided by General Code is now complete. I am working on entering all of the changes into the report that will go back to them so they can finalize our code and prepare the authorizing ordinance for introduction.
