RESOLUTION NO. 10-2021-110

AWARDING CONTRACT TO SEASIDE WASTE FOR SOLID WASTE COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL

WHEREAS the Borough of Barrington has advertised for and received bids for the purpose of "Solid Waste Recyclable Materials Collection Service in the Borough of Barrington"; and

WHEREAS based on the information provided in the specifications and the bid amount submitted, we recommend that a contract be awarded to Seaside Waste Services of Hammonton, New Jersey in the amount of \$1,769,371.00 for the collection of solid waste and recyclables for Option No. 5, Base Bid A and Base Bid B for a five (5) year contract term. In addition, we recommend that the Add Consideration, Bid C, Option 5, be awarded to Seaside Waste Services of Hammonton, New Jersey in the amount of \$1,046,400.00 for the disposal of solid waste for a five (5) year contract term;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Barrington, County of Camden, State of New Jersey, based on the information provided in the specifications and the bid amount submitted, we recommend that a contract be awarded to Seaside Waste Services of Hammonton, New Jersey in the amount of \$1,769,371.00 for the collection of solid waste for Option No. 5, Base Bid A and Base Bid B and the collection of recyclables for a five (5) year contract term. In addition, we recommend that Add Consideration, Bid C, Option 5, be awarded to Seaside Waste Services of Hammonton, New Jersey in the amount of \$1,046,400.00 for the disposal of solid waste for a five (5) year contract term, conditional upon the following:

1. That a certificate has been received from the Municipal Treasurer stating that funds are available for this Contract.
2. Being subject to the Redirect Costs noted in the Contractor's Bid.
3. That the bid documents and bidding procedures have been reviewed and approved by the Municipal Solicitor.
4. That the Mayor and Clerk of this body are hereby authorized to sign and seal this Contract on behalf of the Borough of Barrington.

DESIGNATING OUTDOOR SMOKING AREAS AT PUBLIC WORKS AND THE AMBULANCE BUILDING

2. Ambulance Building—corner of Second and Haines Avenue, in the area of the outdoor picnic table.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that these are the only outdoor locations at Borough owned facilities designated as smoking areas.
