♦Action items: Discuss traffic improvements at the intersection of Moore and Albertson Avenues; Authorize the engineer's office to proceed with roadway improvements to Austin Avenue, Phase 2

◆Review of Engineer's Report

## Administration:

Adoption of the Camden County Hazard Mitigation Plan. Dave Pawling informed us that the County has adopted the revised HMP and that now each town also has to adopt. Dave spearheaded this project for Barrington and with input from the engineer and Mike Ciocco, we updated everything on the plan. The Camden County OEM provided the sample resolution which was emailed to you. This resolution will be on the January council agenda.

♦Public hearing for drainage project—Pennoni, the engineer for the drainage study being done for Audubon, Heights, Haddonfield and Barrington, has advised us that we need to hold a public hearing to inform the public about the project, what is being done, and to get public input. They recommend this be at a separate meeting rather than at a council meeting. They anticipate it being no more than 30 minutes depending on the amount of public feedback. We need to do this ASAP so we need to determine a date and time.

♦MOU with Civic Association—the Civic Association wants to place a shed for storage at Lost World Park. Tim confirms this can be done by a Memorandum of Understanding between the Borough and the Civic Association. The resolution to authorize this will be on the council agenda.

♦Zoom meetings—we will be continuing on Zoom through January and possibly February. We have had a tremendous outbreak of Covid amount borough personnel and bringing people together right now is not a good idea. The Mayor wants to stay on Zoom for at least January and we can revisit if numbers are declining for February or March. It seems the winter months are going to remain a challenge as Covid variants continue to emerge. •Ordinance for a revised property registration program—as you are aware, we suspended the property registration program because of the recent Atlantic County court decisions. We discussed introducing a new ordinance revising the program for 2022. We need to discuss how the program will work and authorize Tim to prepare the ordinance for introduction.
