RESOLUTION OF AGREEMENT BY AND BETWEEN THE BOROUGH OF BARRINGTON AND JOSEPH GALLO PERMITTING THE REIMBURSEMENT OF CERTAIN EDUCATIONAL BENEFITS

WHEREAS the Barrington Regional Fire Alliance has in its employ Joseph Gallo (hereinafter, "Gallo"), currently in the position of Fire Alliance Inspector; and

WHEREAS Gallo has applied and has been accepted to the NJIAAI Basic Arson Investigator Course to pursue a certification as an arson investigator through the International Association of Arson Investigators, NJ Chapter, which would be beneficial to his position in the Regional Fire Alliance; and

WHEREAS Gallo has requested of the Borough reimbursement reimburse the cost of this certification program in the amount of \$750.00; and

WHEREAS Gallo has agreed to reimburse the Borough any benefits received under this Resolution should he leave the Borough's employ within three (3) years of obtaining this certificate; and

WHEREAS the Borough Council of the Borough of Barrington deems this action to be in the best interest of the Borough of Barrington and the Regional Fire Alliance;
