AUTHORIZING SUBMISSION OF A LEAP GRANT APPLICATION WITH THE BOROUGH OF HADDONFIELD AND HADDON HEIGHTS

WHEREAS the State of New Jersey has appropriated \$10 million for Shared Services and School District Consolidation Study and Implementation Grants to assist local units with the study, development, and implementation of new shared and regional services; and

WHEREAS the Department of Community Affairs, Division of Local Government Services (DLGS) is tasked with administering these grant funds through the Local Efficiency Achievement Program (LEAP); and

WHEREAS LEAP Implementation Grants exist to support costs associated with shared service implementation to ensure that meaningful, efficiency generating initiatives are not hindered by short term transitional expenses; and

WHEREAS the Borough of Haddonfield (lead agenda), along with the Boroughs of Barrington and Haddon Heights, propose to enter into a shared services agreement, but face certain expenses associated with implementation that present a burden to the local units; and

WHEREAS the purpose of this shared services agreement is to develop a Tri-Borough Emergency Services Study & Implementation Plan, which will benefit the residents of all of the participating local units; and

WHEREAS the Borough of Haddonfield has agreed to be the lead agency in this program and will submit the application to DLGS on behalf of all participating units; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Governing Body of the Borough of Barrington, that Barrington does hereby join with the Boroughs of Haddonfield and Haddon Heights in applying for a LEAP Implementation Grant in the amount of \$75,000.00 to support implementation of this shared service.

WHEREAS Kevin Hibbitt (hereinafter "Hibbitt") was employed as a Police Officer in the Borough of Barrington (hereinafter "Borough"); and

WHEREAS on May 24, 2021, the Borough served Hibbitt with a Preliminary Notice of Disciplinary Action ("PNDA"); and

WHEREAS Hibbitt and the Borough now wish to resolve the PNDA, without the necessity of a departmental hearing being held, without the necessity of Final Disciplinary Charges being issued, and without the necessity of appeals from same being taken; and

WHEREAS Hibbitt and the Borough acknowledge that the merits of the controversies were in dispute and were never fully adjudicated, but all have reasons to desire amicable resolution of the collective matters; and

WHEREAS Hibbitt and the Borough have engaged in settlement negotiations regarding the aforementioned PNDA, and as a result of those settlement negotiations, all controversies between Hibbitt and the Borough have been resolved; and

WHEREAS the Governing Body is of the opinion that the settlement is in the best interests of the Borough; and

WHEREAS the Governing Body has been advised that Hibbitt retired from his position as Police Officer with the Borough Police Department effective March 1, 2022; and

WHEREAS the Borough believes it appropriate and necessary to execute a Settlement Agreement and Release detailing the settlement reached, and a Settlement Agreement and Release has been prepared and same has been found to be acceptable by Hibbitt and the Borough;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by Mayor and Council of the Borough of Barrington, County of Camden, State of New Jersey that the Settlement Agreement and Release between the Borough and Hibbitt attached hereto as Exhibit "A", is hereby approved; and
