**WHEREAS** the Borough Engineer has reviewed the bids and has recommended that a contract be awarded to Pioneer General Contracting Co., Inc; and

**WHEREAS** the Municipal Solicitor has reviewed the bids and bidding procedures and approved same; and

**WHEREAS** the Finance Officer has certified that funds are available for award of this contract in the Capital Budget;
