

**ORDINANCE NO. 1162**

**ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 29, POLICE DEPARTMENT, IN THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF BARRINGTON**

**BE IT ORDAINED**, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Barrington, County of Camden, and State of New Jersey, that the following section in Chapter 29, Police Department, is amended as follows:

**ARTICLE I.                    § 29-4        Police qualifications.**

To be eligible to appointment in the Police Department, a person must be not less than 18 nor more than 35 years of age; must be a citizen of the United States; must be of good moral character; and must be able to read and write the English language understandably. He or she shall be in good health and sound in mind and body, as certified by the Borough Physician, who shall also certify that he or she is physically capable of performing the duties required of a police officer and shall satisfy the requirements for membership in the state Police and Firemen's Retirement System. The Public Safety Committee shall examine all applicants for appointment from an educational, mental and moral standpoint and, after also considering the report of the Borough Physician, make their recommendations to the Mayor.

**ARTICLE II.**

All Ordinances contrary to the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent that they are inconsistent herewith.

**ARTICLE III.**

This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication according to law.
