RESOLUTION OF THE BOROUGH OF BARRINGTON, COUNTY OF CAMDEN AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AUTHORIZING A SHARED SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH THE BOROUGH OF RUNNEMEDE RELATIVE TO EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES

WHEREAS the Borough of Runnemede (hereinafter "Runnemede") is a municipal entity organized under the laws of the State of New Jersey and located in Camden County; and

WHEREAS the Borough of Barrington (hereinafter "Barrington") is a municipal entity organized under the laws of the State of New Jersey and located in Camden County; and

WHEREAS the Borough of Barrington Ambulance Association (hereinafter "BAA") is a not-forprofit corporation organized under the laws of the State of New Jersey and located in Camden County; and

WHEREAS the Borough of Barrington, within its Department of Public Safety, renders support to the Barrington Ambulance Association, which provides certain emergency medical services to the residents of the Boroughs of Barrington and Haddon Heights; and

WHEREAS the Borough of Barrington and the Borough of Runnemede wish to enter into a Shared Services Agreement pursuant to the New Jersey Uniform Shared Services and Consolidation Act, N.J.S.A. 40A:65-1 et seq., relative to the providing of certain emergency medical services to the residents of the Borough of Runnemede; and

WHEREAS Barrington has agreed to permit the Barrington Ambulance Association to provide the same emergency medical services to the residents of the Borough of Runnemede as it provides to the residents of the Boroughs of Barrington and Haddon Heights for the period commencing August 1, 2022, through December 31, 2032, with the exception that services will not be required Monday through Friday from 6:00am—3:00pm; and

WHEREAS Barrington Ambulance Association has agreed to provide the same emergency medical services to the residents of the Borough of Runnemede as it provides to the residents of the Boroughs of Barrington and Haddon Heights, for the period of time commencing August 1, 2022, through December 31, 2023, with the exception as stated above; and

WHEREAS Runnemede has agreed to pay Barrington the sum of Seventy-Five Thousand Dollars (\$75,000.00) per annum during the pendency of this Agreement, payable in accordance with the payment schedule as set forth in the Agreement; and

WHEREAS Runnemede, Barrington and the Barrington Ambulance Association intend by virtue of the document, attached hereto as Exhibit "A," to set forth the terms and conditions of this Agreement; and

WHEREAS Barrington, by virtue of the document attached hereto as Exhibit "A," wishes to authorize its proper and respective municipal officials to execute this Shared Services Agreement on behalf of the Borough of Barrington;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Barrington, County of Camden, State of New Jersey, that the Shared Services Agreement, pursuant to the New Jersey Uniform Shared Services and Consolidation Act, N.J.S.A. 40A:65-1 et seq., by and between the Borough of Runnemede, the Borough of Barrington and the Barrington Ambulance Association, relative to the providing of certain emergency medical services to the residents of the Borough of Runnemede, be and hereby is approved; and

RESOLUTION OF THE BOROUGH OF BARRINGTON, COUNTY OF CAMDEN AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY, GRANTING CERTAIN SERVICE CREDITS TO GARY HAWKINS RELATIVE TO HIS LENGTH OF SERVICE WITH THE BOROUGH OF BARRINGTON

WHEREAS Gary Hawkins commenced his employment with the Borough of Barrington on December 1, 2004, being currently employed and having seventeen (17) years and seven (7) months of service as a police officer in the Borough of Barrington; and

WHEREAS Gary Hawkins commenced his association with the Barrington Fire Department in January of 1995, currently having approximately twenty-seven (27) years of service as a fire fighter or the Barrington Fire Department; and

WHEREAS the Borough Council of the Borough of Barrington has determined that, as an incentive for the retirement of Gary Hawkins from his employment as a police officer with the Borough of Barrington, that he be credited, for the sole purpose of the computation of time required for the eligibility for certain benefits under Section F. of Page 95 – Group Medical Benefits, of the Borough of Barrington Personnel Policies and Procedures Manual, with the service time accumulated by Gary Hawkins as a fire fighter for the Barrington Fire Department in addition to the service time credited to Gary Hawkins as a police officer in the Borough of Barrington; and

WHEREAS the Borough Council of the Borough of Barrington deems this action to be in the best interests of the Borough of Barrington during this budgetary time;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Barrington that, effective April 1, 2023, Gary Hawkins is and hereby is granted a total of twenty (20) years of service time with the Borough of Barrington, recognizing the approximate twenty-seven (27) years of service time accumulated by Gary Hawkins as a fire fighter for the Barrington Fire Department in addition to the eighteen (18) years and three (3) months of service time Gary Hawkins will have accumulated as a police officer as of April 1, 2023; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Borough Council of the Borough of Barrington grants this service time as an incentive for the retirement of Gary Hawkins from his employment with the Borough of Barrington; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this service time credit is for the sole purpose of the computation of service time required for the eligibility for certain benefits under Section F. of Page 95 — Group Medical Benefits, of the Borough of Barrington Personnel Policies and Procedures Manual, as will be accumulated by Gary Hawkins as of April 1, 2023, from his employment with the Borough of Barrington; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that should Gary Hawkins not retire from active duty as a police officer in the Borough of Barrington by April 1, 2023, this Resolution is hereby repealed and revoked, is null and void, and is of no force and effect.
