ORDINANCE NO. 1164

AMENDING CHAPTER 59, FIRE PREVENTION, IN THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF BARRINGTON

BE IT HEREBY ORDINAINED by the Governing Body of the Borough of Barrington, that Chapter 59, Fire Prevention, is hereby amended as follows:

ARTICLE I. § 59-8 Permit fees.

A. The fees for permits shall be as follows.

Type I	\$74
Type II	\$268
Type III	\$509
Type IV	\$777

B. Application.

Application shall be made to the Fire Official for the uses and/or activities set forth in § **59-8A**. No application for a permit shall be acted upon unless such application is submitted 10 working days prior to an inspection.

C. Code status reports.

The fee for a Fire Code status report shall be \$100.

D. Fire reports.

When not an Open Public Records Act (OPRA) requested report, the cost for a detailed fire investigation summary report will be as follows:

- (1) Fire cause and origin reports: \$140 (fire report only).
- (2) Fire scene photos: \$70 (fire photos only).
- (3) Total for both report and photos: \$210.

§ 59-9 Inspection of non-life-hazard uses.

- A. The local enforcing agency established by § 59-2 shall carry out non-life-hazard inspections of uses and/or activities. Failure to register with this office within 30 days of receipt of a bill will result in your annual fee being doubled. If doubled annual registration fee is not paid within 60 days, then that will result in court and legal action. The annual registration fees for non-life-hazard uses and/or activities will be as follows:
- (1) Residential buildings with dwelling units not listed as life-hazard by the New Jersey Bureau of Fire Safety, except one- or two-family owner-occupied units:

(2) Commercial or industrial use group includes all buildings not listed as life-hazard by the New Jersey Bureau of Fire Safety. Each floor or story shall be calculated as separate areas for total building calculation.

B. Smoke and carbon monoxide detector inspections.

- (1) Smoke and carbon monoxide detector inspections, to be conducted on all one- and two-family residential dwellings for resale being sold within our local LEA, shall be charged as follows:
- (a) Request received 14+ business days prior: \$66.
- (b) Request received eight to 13 business days prior: \$74.
- (c) Request received four to seven business days prior: \$106.
- (d) Request received three business days or less prior: \$171.
- (2) The above fee entitles the applicant to one inspection. A reinspection due to a failure would require a payment of \$50 for the reinspection.
- (3) A certificate is valid for a period of six months from the date of issuance.
- (4) All towns in the LEA shall allow the Regional Fire Prevention Alliance to conduct smoke detector/CO inspections at the above fee schedule.
- (5) Every home resale or tenant change-out will require smoke/CO detectors to be installed in all bedrooms.

ARTICLE II.

All Ordinances contrary to the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent that they are inconsistent herewith.

ARTICLE III.

This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication according to law.
