### **Administration**

- •Aetna and Virtua have come to terms and settled on a contract. There will be no interruption in healthcare services and Virtua will remain in the Aetna network.
- •Bellmawr sewer connections—401 and 402 Fifth Avenue have recently connected to Bellmawr's sewer. Barrington does not have sewer service where they are located. We will be approving a resolution for a shared service with Bellmawr for this service and Barrington will bill the residents and Bellmawr will bill Barrington for the service.
- •Resolution authorizing ERI to perform the Master Plan reexamination and update of the Redevelopment ordinances. Proposal for both is \$21,000 and Denise will include this in the 2023 budget.
- •Amendment to zoning ordinance for cannabis facilities—the ordinance we adopted erroneously allowed consumption of cannabis at a facility. That was basically creating smoking lounges. It was not the intention that consumption be permitted so an ordinance amending the original ordinance will be introduced at the February 14 meeting. Also, the application for a cannabis retail facility in Barrington has been finalized and is ready to go. A copy is attached for your review.
- •Renewal of the shared services agreement for the Regional Fire Alliance—the shared services with the four towns in the Alliance expired December 31. We sent the language for the new agreement to the state so they could approve the language. They are taking their time and asked us not to do anything with the agreement until we hear back from them.
- •Promotion of patrolman to corporal—Officer Tyrell Thomas is being promoted to corporal and that resolution will be on the council agenda.
