WHEREAS officers of the Barrington Police Department are permitted to perform extra duty services for private contractors at a rate established by the current employment contract by and between PBA Local 328 and the Borough of Barrington; and

WHEREAS the Barrington Police Department desires to enter into a contract with Hart Halsey, LLC, d/b/a Extra Duty Solutions, for the performance of certain administrative services related to the scheduling, billing and performance of said extra duty services; and

WHEREAS the contract would allow for the Barrington Police Department to shift some of the administrative duties related to extra duty services to Extra Duty Solutions; and

WHEREAS there is no cost to the Borough for this service as the fee for service is added to the billing going to the contractor who requested the extra duty services; and

WHEREAS the term of this Agreement shall be for an initial period of one year; and

WHEREAS it has been determined that the benefits provided for under this contract are in the best interest of the Borough of Barrington and the Barrington Police Department;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Governing Body of the Borough of Barrington, that a contract for the administration of the police extra duty program be awarded to Hart Halsey, LLC, d/b/a Extra Duty Solutions; and
