WHEREAS the Borough of Barrington Ambulance Association (hereinafter "BAA") is a not-forprofit corporation organized under the laws of the State of New Jersey and located in Camden County; and

WHEREAS the Borough of Barrington, within its Department of Public Safety, renders support to the Barrington Ambulance Association, which provides certain emergency medical services to the residents of the Boroughs of Barrington and Haddon Heights; and

WHEREAS the Borough of Barrington and the Borough of Runnemede entered into a Shared Services Agreement in August of 2022, pursuant to the New Jersey Uniform Shared Services and Consolidation Act, N.J.S.A. 40A:65-1 et seq., relative to the providing of certain emergency medical services to the residents of the Borough of Runnemede; and

WHEREAS said Shared Services Agreement was subsequently amended on May 9, 2023, by Resolution 5-2023-56; and

WHEREAS it is necessary to again amend said Shared Services Agreement to provide additional EMS coverage to Runnemede and the terms of said amendment have been negotiated by and between Barrington Ambulance Association and the Borough of Runnemede, a copy of which is annexed hereto; and

WHEREAS Runnemede, Barrington and the Barrington Ambulance Association intend by virtue of the document, attached hereto as Exhibit "A," to set forth the terms and conditions of this second Amendment to the Shared Services Agreement; and

WHEREAS Barrington, by virtue of the document attached hereto as Exhibit "A," wishes to authorize its proper and respective municipal officials to execute this second Amendment to the Shared Services Agreement on behalf of the Borough of Barrington;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Barrington, County of Camden, State of New Jersey, that the second Amendment to the Shared Services Agreement, pursuant to the New Jersey Uniform Shared Services and Consolidation

Act, N.J.S.A. 40A:65-1 et seq., by and between the Borough of Runnemede, the Borough of Barrington and the Barrington Ambulance Association, relative to the providing of certain emergency medical services to the residents of the Borough of Runnemede, be and hereby is approved; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Patti Harris, Mayor of the Borough of Barrington, and Terry Shannon, Borough Clerk of the Borough of Barrington, be and are hereby authorized to execute the second Shared Services Amendment, attached hereto as Exhibit "A," under the terms and conditions as set forth above; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution will become effective upon the adoption of a similar Resolution by the Borough Council of the Borough of Runnemede authorizing its Mayor and Borough Clerk to execute the second Shared Services Amendment attached hereto as Exhibit "A," on behalf of the Borough of Runnemede.

AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH PENNONI FOR GIS IMPLEMENTATION SERVICES

WHEREAS the Borough of Barrington entered into a shared services agreement with the boroughs of Haddonfield, Audubon and Haddon Heights, for the purpose of having a stormwater drainage study done of the respective towns with Haddonfield as the lead agency and with funding through a NJDCA LEAP grant; and

WHEREAS Haddonfield developed an RFP for engineering services to perform the drainage study, which was subsequently advertised, proposals received were reviewed by all four towns and a contract was awarded to Pennoni, of Haddon Heights, NJ; and

WHEREAS in conjunction with this drainage study, Pennoni prepared a combined digitized stormwater drainage study for the combined areas of Barrington, Audubon, Haddon Heights and Haddonfield; and

WHEREAS in order to create a more usable map just for Barrington, Pennoni proposes the use of an ESRI Product Delivery Subscription (PDS) as a GIS web interface which will allow the Borough to access and manage stormwater assets, as well as other assets in the future; and

WHEREAS DPW Superintendent Mike Ciocco, as well as the borough engineer, have recommended that this GIS web interface for the stormwater drainage system in Barrington would be a very valuable tool as no GIS mapping of the stormwater system currently exists and is sorely needed; and

WHEREAS Pennoni submitted a proposal dated December 21, 2022, to develop and implement this GIS web application in the amount of \$10,000; and

WHEREAS funds have been provided for this project in the 2023 Municipal Budget; and

WHEREAS the Governing Body has determined that implementation of this GIS web interface would be in the best interests of the Borough of Barrington;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Governing Body of the Borough of Barrington, County of Camden, State of New Jersey, that the proposal submitted by Pennoni for implementation a GIS web interface of the borough's stormwater system is hereby accepted and the Mayor and Clerk are authorized to execute an agreement with Pennoni for this purpose.
