RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING EMERGENCY REPAIRS TO THE SANITARY SEWER FORCEMAIN AT THE FOURTH AVENUE SANITARY SEWER PUMP STATION

WHEREAS on January 4, 2024, the Public Works Sewer Department determined that sewage was overflowing out of the ground from the sanitary sewer force main adjacent to the Fourth Avenue sanitary sewer pump station; and

WHEREAS the Public Works Sewer Department staff investigated the matter further and upon further investigation, it was determined that the sanitary sewer force main was found to be broken and discharging effluent onto the adjacent residential properties and ditch; and

WHEREAS on January 4, 2024, the Public Works Sewer Department commenced with their Bypass Contingency Plan by contacting Xylem and Pioneer Pipe Contractors to assist the Department with the installation of a 24-hour bypass pumping system consisting of a bypass pump and approximately 2,650 linear feet of 8" diameter overland piping and its installation to eliminate the health hazard; and

WHEREAS on January 4, 2024, Pioneer Pipe Contractors completed the installation of the 24-hour bypass pumping system and on January 5, 2024, they completed the sanitary sewer force main repair in the presence of the Public Works Sewer Department and the Borough of Barrington Engineer representative; and

WHEREAS based on the investigation the existing broken cast iron sanitary sewer force main being brittle it was determined that its condition is likely due to being subject to high levels of hydrogen sulfide and the high acidic soils for approximately sixty (60) years and, based on its working environment, the cast iron sanitary sewer force main has outlived its expected life; and

WHEREAS the discharge of sanitary effluent is considered a potential health hazard, and such a discharge must be resolved, immediately, in accordance with New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection rules and regulations; and

WHEREAS the Barrington Borough Engineer and the Sewer System Operator of the Borough of Barrington evaluated the situation and determined that the emergency sanitary sewer force main replacement was necessary to eliminate the discharge of raw sewage, to avoid potential health hazards and, to avoid the potential service disruptions to businesses and residents; and

WHEREAS that such emergency affects the public health, safety and welfare of the Borough of Barrington and must be addressed as soon as practically possible; and
