Renewal of agreement with animal control officer (ACO)—we received the renewal from our current ACO and they are keeping the pricing for 2026 the same as 2025. Resolution to renew for 2026 will be on the agenda.

Renewal of agreement with animal orphanage—we received the renewal from our current animal orphanage, Voorhees Animal Orphanage, and they too are keeping the 2026 pricing the same as 2025. Resolution to renew for 2026 will be on the agenda.

Renewal of participation in the Camden County Joint Insurance Fund—our three year agreement to be a member of the Camden County Joint Insurance Fund expires December 31 and needs to be renewed. Resolution to renew will be on the agenda.

Resolution for dates for January meetings—the January Reorg meeting will be Tuesday, January 6, 2026, at 6:00pm, followed by caucus immediately after. Resolution to set those dates will be on the council agenda.

Resolution for three-month shared service agreement with Mount Ephraim—I have agreed to stay on as a consultant for the new clerk in Mount Ephraim but for just six hours per week for January through March. Resolution will be on the council agenda.

Renewal of shared services agreement for court—Oaklyn has revised the shared services agreement for municipal court because Stratford has been added. The new agreement will be a three-year from 2026-2028 and will result in a savings for each of the original towns. For 2026, we will realize a reduction of \$18,360.00.

Approval of shared services agreement with Camden County for unhoused residents—Camden County has a new program for unhoused residents and all county municipalities can avail themselves of the services through the shared services agreement they provided. The agreement was emailed to you directly for your review. This covers unhoused residents and Code Blue. Mayor Hanson and Chief Minardi can provide more information as they attended the county meeting.
