AUTHORIZING A SHARED SERVICES AGREEMENT BY AND BETWEEN THE BOROUGH OF RUNNEMEDE AND THE BOROUGH OF BARRINGTON RELATIVE TO THE SERVICES OF A QUALIFIED PURCHASING AGENT BY AND FOR THE BOROUGH OF BARRINGTON

THIS DOCUMENT constitutes a Shared Services Agreement pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:65-1 et seq. entered into by and between the Borough of Barrington, a body politic and corporate of the State of New Jersey with offices located at 229 Trenton Avenue, Barrington, New Jersey 08007 (Barrington), and the Borough of Runnemede, a body politic and corporate of the State of New Jersey with offices located at 24 North Black Horse Pike, Runnemede, New Jersey 08078 (Runnemede). The date of the execution of this Agreement is the first day of May 2026.

W I T N E S S E T H

WHEREAS, the Borough of Barrington (hereinafter "Barrington") is a municipal entity organized under the laws of the State of New Jersey and located in Camden County; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Runnemede (hereinafter "Runnemede") is a municipal entity organized under the laws of the State of New Jersey and located in Camden County; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Runnemede has in its employ a certain individual known as Shelley Strehle who has been appointed by Runnemede as the Qualified Purchasing Agent (hereinafter "QPA") for the Borough of Runnemede; and

WHEREAS, Shelley Strehle (hereinafter "Strehle") is a licensed QPA in the State of New Jersey pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:9-12.1 ("Statutes") and the regulations promulgated thereunder ("Regulations"); and

WHEREAS, Runnemede has agreed to permit Strehle to act as the QPA in the Borough of Barrington, in addition to the duties assigned by Runnemede to Strehle as an employee of Runnemede; and

WHEREAS, Barrington has agreed to pay Runnemede up to Four Thousand Dollars (\$4,000) for service from May 1 through December 31 in the calendar year 2026, to be paid in accordance with the payment schedule set forth below; and

WHEREAS, Barrington and Runnemede intend by virtue of this document to set forth the terms and conditions of this Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the proper and respective municipal officials were authorized to execute this Shared Services Agreement pursuant to Resolutions of their respective Councils, attached hereto and made a part of this Agreement; and

NOW, THEREFORE, AND IN CONSIDERATION of the mutual promises set forth herein, the parties hereto agree as follows:

1. TERM

This Agreement shall be for a period of eight months commencing on May 1, 2026, and ending on December 31, 2026.

2. Qualified Purchasing Agent

Strehle shall perform all of the duties of the QPA in the Borough of Barrington, and Strehle shall advise Barrington what hours that Strehle will be available in order to complete all duties required of a Qualified Purchasing Agent during the term of this engagement.

3. ALLOCATION OF PAYMENTS

Barrington shall pay to Runnemede the sum of Four Thousand Dollars (\$4,000) in monthly increments of Five Hundred Dollar (\$500) as of May 15 in the calendar year 2026. The appropriate vouchers shall be provided by Runnemede. This figure is inclusive of salary and all costs which are related to this employment.

4. EMPLOYMENT STATUS

It is acknowledged by Barrington, Runnemede, and Strehle that Strehle shall not be an employee of Barrington, but in fact shall be an employee of Runnemede and any payments made hereunder by Barrington to Runnemede shall be deemed in the nature of third-party payments by these municipalities on a "vendor" basis.

Strehle acknowledges that in the event of a termination of this Agreement by any or all of the parties, she will not be paid any sum in excess of the salary committed by Runnemede for the Qualified Purchasing Agent salary. Strehle further waives and relinquishes any right that Strehle may have against Runnemede for additional compensation pursuant to any statute or regulation other than the compensation as set forth above.

Barrington and Runnemede acknowledge that this Agreement shall be null and void in the event of either a voluntary or involuntary termination of Strehle during the term of this Agreement. The parties, at their option, shall either replace Strehle immediately with a QPA acceptable to all parties, or any or both parties may seek any other means of replacement consistent with the laws of the State of New Jersey.

5. AUDIT

Pursuant to the Single Audit Act of 1984, Runnemede agrees to permit Barrington and/or its agents to examine any and all records relevant to this Agreement and shall make the same available upon demand at a reasonable time and place for the purpose of auditing the records, reports, and documents relative to this Agreement.

6. INDEMNIFICATION

Barrington shall indemnify, hold harmless and defend Runnemede, its elected officials, employees, officers and agents, from and against all liability, claims, suits, losses, damages, costs and demands, on account of bodily injury, including death or property damage, arising out of or connected with the performance of the services under this Agreement.

Runnemede shall indemnify, hold harmless and defend Barrington, its elected officials, employees, officers and agents, from and against all liability, claims, suits, losses, damages, costs and demands, on account of bodily injury, including death or property damage, arising out of or connected with the performance of the services under this Agreement.

7. NOTICES

All notices hereunder shall be in writing and sent via electronic email with return receipt for the Borough of Runnemede to the Borough Clerk, Borough of Runnemede, 24 North Black Horse Pike, Runnemede, New Jersey 08078; and for the Borough of Barrington to the Borough Clerk, Borough of Barrington, 229 Trenton Ave, Barrington, New Jersey 08007.

8. MISCELLANEOUS

The following provisions shall apply to this Agreement:

A. Construction of this Agreement

The parties acknowledge that this Agreement was prepared under New Jersey Law and shall therefore be interpreted under the laws of that State.

B. Amendments

This Agreement may not be amended, altered, or modified in any manner except in writing signed by the parties hereto.

C. Headings

This section and any other headings contained in this Agreement are for reference only and shall not affect the meaning and interpretation of this contract.

D. Invalid Clause

The invalidity of any clause contained herein shall not render any other provision invalid and the balance of this Agreement shall be binding upon all parties hereto.

E. Entire Agreement

This Agreement shall consist of the entire Agreement of the parties and it is acknowledged that there are no side or oral Agreements relating to this undertaking set forth herein.

F. Assignability

This Agreement and all rights, duties and obligations contained herein may not be assigned without Runnemede's prior written permission.

G. Affirmative Action

The affirmative action provisions set forth in the documents attached hereto are incorporated herein and made a part hereof.

H. Funding

In accordance with the provisions of N.J.S.A. 40A:11-15, this Agreement is subject to the availability and appropriation of sufficient funds in the year in which it is in effect.

I. Waiver

It is understood and agreed by the parties that a failure or delay in the enforcement of any of the provisions of this Agreement by either of the parties shall not be construed as a waiver of those provisions.

RESOLUTION OF THE BOROUGH OF BARRINGTON, COUNTY OF CAMDEN AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY AUTHORIZING CROWN CASTLE FIBER LLC, TO PLACE SMALL WIRELESS FACILITIES WITHIN THE PUBLIC RIGHT OF WAY TO ENHANCE ITS WIRELESS COMMUNICATIONS NETWORK IN THE BOROUGH OF BARRINGTON

WHEREAS, the Borough of Barrington is a municipal corporation organized under the laws of the State of New Jersey and located in Camden County, New Jersey ("Barrington"); and

WHEREAS, Crown Castle Fiber LLC, is a telecommunications utility in New Jersey, ("Crown Castle"), an FCC-licensed provider of commercial mobile service subject to regulation by the Federal Communications Commission; and

WHEREAS, Crown Castle has entered into agreements with parties that have the lawful right to maintain poles in the public right-of-way pursuant to which Crown Castle may use existing utility poles, replace existing poles or install new poles as necessary within the public right-of-way in the Borough of Barrington; and

WHEREAS, New Jersey law permits such use provided that there is the consent of the relevant municipality, and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Borough Council of the Borough of Barrington, County of Camden, State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. Permission and authority are hereby granted to Crown Castle and its successors and assigns, to use existing poles, replace existing poles or install new poles as necessary within the public right-of-way in the Borough of Barrington subject to the following:

a. Crown Castle, and its successors and assigns, shall adhere to all applicable Federal, State, and Local laws regarding safety requirements related to the use of the public right of way.

b. In accordance with FCC Order 18-133, Crown Castle agrees to pay the following fees to the Borough of Barrington:

i. A one-time non-recurring Application Fee of \$500.00 for a single application covering up to five small wireless facilities, with an additional \$100.00 for each facility beyond the fifth.

ii. Annual Recurring Fee of \$270.00 per small wireless facility for ongoing access to the public right-of-way.

c. Crown Castle, and its successors and assigns, shall comply with all applicable Federal, State, and Local laws requiring permits prior to beginning construction, and shall obtain any applicable permits, if any, that may be required by the Borough of Barrington.

d. Such permission shall be and is hereby given upon the condition and provision that Crown Castle, and its successors and assigns, shall indemnify, defend and hold harmless the Borough of Barrington, its officers, agents and servants, from any claim of liability or loss or bodily injury or property damage resulting from or arising out of the acts or omissions of Crown Castle or its agents in connection with the construction, use and occupancy

of utility poles located within the public right-of-way, except to the extent resulting from the acts or omissions of the Borough of Barrington.

e. Crown Castle shall, at its own cost and expense, maintain commercial general liability insurance with limits not less than \$1,000,000.00 for injury to or death of one or more persons in any one occurrence and \$500,000.00 for damage or destruction to property in any one occurrence. Crown Castle shall include the Borough of Barrington as an additional insured.

f. Crown Castle shall, at its own cost and expense, secure a permit from Camden County Public Works while working on the roadways designated as a County Road by the County of Camden.

g. Crown Castle shall supply the Borough Public Works Superintendent with a detailed map showing the proposed location of the small wireless facilities before installation. The Borough reserves the right to reject a proposed location or request relocation of the proposed location of the small wireless facilities.

h. Crown Castle shall be responsible for the repair of any damage to paving, existing utility lines, or any surface or subsurface installations arising from its construction, installation or maintenance of its facilities.

i. Notwithstanding any provision contained herein, neither the Borough of Barrington nor Crown Castle shall be liable to the other for consequential, incidental, exemplary, or punitive damages on account of any activity pursuant to this instrument.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Barrington Borough Clerk shall forward a certified copy of this Resolution to the following parties:

1. Crown Castle LLC; and
2. Barrington Borough Department of Public Works; and
3. Barrington Borough Construction Department; and
4. All other Interested Parties.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED the Mayor and Borough Clerk of the Borough of Barrington be and hereby are authorized to execute and attest to any and all documentation that may be necessary to effectuate this permission and authority.
