NOTICE OF PENDING BOND ORDINANCE AND SUMMARY

Bond ordinance 1229, the summary terms of which are included herein, was introduced and passed upon first reading at a regular meeting of the governing body of the Borough of Barrington, in the County of Camden, State of New Jersey, on March 10, 2026, in accordance with New Jersey law. It will be further considered for final passage, after public hearing thereon, at a meeting of the governing body to be held at Barrington Municipal Building, 229 Trenton Avenue, Barrington, New Jersey 08007 on April 14, 2026, at 6:00 p.m. During the week prior to and up to and including the date of such meeting, copies of the full ordinance will be available at no cost and during regular business hours, at the Clerk's office for the members of the general public who shall request the same. The summary of the terms of such bond ordinance follows:

Title: BOND ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR VARIOUS IMPROVEMENTS TO THE BEAVERBROOK AREA IN THE BOROUGH OF BARRINGTON, IN THE COUNTY OF CAMDEN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY; APPROPRIATING \$1,100,000 THEREFOR AND AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF \$1,100,000 BONDS OR NOTES TO FINANCE PART OF THE COST THEREOF

Purpose(s): Various Improvements To The Beaverbrook Area Of The Borough Including, But Not Limited To, The Discharge Area At Shreve Avenue, The Removal And Reconstruction Of The Concrete Spillway, The Removal Of Debris And The Reconstruction/Stabilization Of Brooks Banks, Such Improvements Including, But Not Limited To, As Applicable, Milling, Paving, Reconstruction And Resurfacing Of The Roadway, The Repairing And/Or Installation Of Drainage Improvements, Landscaping And Aesthetic Improvements.
