## CASH PAYMENT ROUNDING POLICY

1. Rounding of Cash Transactions
  - a. When a customer pays a Tax or Sewer bill in cash, the final balance due shall be rounded up to the nearest \$0.05 (five cents).
  - b. This rounding applies only to the cash payment process and does not alter the actual billed amount recorded in the Borough's accounting system.
2. Rounding Rules
  - a. Amounts ending in \$0.01 through \$0.04 will be rounded to \$0.05.
  - b. Amounts ending in \$0.06 through \$0.09 will be rounded up to the next \$0.10.
  - c. No amount will be rounded down under any circumstance.
3. Application of Excess
  - a. Any amount collected above the exact billed charge due to rounding shall be credited to the customer's next quarterly Tax and/or Sewer bill.
  - b. The credit will be shown on the customer's receipt and/or the next billing statement.
4. Electronic Payments Unaffected
  - a. This rounding policy does not apply to payments made by check, ACH, credit/debit card, or online payment platforms.

Borough staff responsible for billing and collections shall implement this policy. The borough may revise the policy as needed based on operational or financial considerations.

**WHEREAS** Barrington, the HOA, and the Property Owners intend, by virtue the document attached hereto as "Exhibit A," to set forth the terms and conditions of this Agreement; and

**WHEREAS** the Borough Council of the Borough of Barrington believe it to be in the best interest of the Borough for the Borough to assume the responsibility for the operation and maintenance of this sanitary sewer pump station and detention basin located within the Hidden Ponds Development;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of Barrington, that the Agreement relative to the assumption of responsibility by the Borough for the operation and maintenance of the sanitary sewer pump station and detention basin located within the Hidden Ponds Development be and hereby is **APPROVED**; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that Kyle Hanson, Mayor of the Borough of Barrington, Timothy J. Higgins, Esquire, Borough Attorney for the Borough of Barrington and Denise Moules, Borough Clerk of the Borough of Barrington be and hereby are authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the terms and conditions of this Agreement on behalf of the Borough of Barrington.
