

Ordinance 1240 Amending Chapter 339, Vehicles and Traffic of the Borough Code

The foregoing ordinance was introduced by Mayor and Council at the regular meeting held on June 9, 2016. This Ordinance will be considered for adoption on final reading and public hearing to be held on July 14, 2016 at 6:00 p.m. in the Council Meeting Room, Barrington Municipal Building, 229 Trenton Avenue, Barrington, New Jersey.

The purpose of this Ordinance is to designate an all-way stop control for the intersection of Oak Avenue and Clinton Avenue in the Borough of Barrington.
