

ORDINANCE NO. 1241

**ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF BARRINGTON, COUNTY OF CAMDEN AND
STATE OF NEW JERSEY TO AMENDING ARTICLE III TO CHAPTER 313,
TAXATION, IN THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF BARRINGTON**

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Borough Council of the Borough of Barrington, County of Camden, and State of New Jersey, that Article III. in Chapter 313, Taxation, is hereby added to the Code of the Borough of Barrington, as follows:

**ARTICLE III.
Cannabis Municipal Tax**

ARTICLE I. ARTICLE III. SECTION 313-12 Cannabis Municipal Tax.

Pursuant to Section 40 of the New Jersey Cannabis Regulatory, Enforcement and Marketplace Modernization Act (CREAMMA), a two percent (2%) municipal transfer tax shall be imposed on the lawful sale of cannabis by any Class III (wholesaler) and/or Class V (retail) license holder.

ARTICLE II.

All Ordinances contrary to the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent that they are inconsistent herewith.

ARTICLE III.

This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication according to law.

The purpose of this Ordinance is to subject Class III and Class V cannabis businesses to a two percent (2%) municipal transfer tax imposed on the lawful sale of cannabis pursuant to Section 40 of CREAMMA on the lawful sale of cannabis.
