BOND ORDINANCE STATEMENTS AND SUMMARY**

Bond ordinance No. 1229, the summary terms of which are included herein, has been finally adopted by Borough Council of the Borough of Barrington, in the County of Camden, State of New Jersey on April 14, 2026 and the twenty (20) day period of limitation within which a suit, action or proceeding questioning the validity of such ordinance can be commenced, as provided in the Local Bond Law, has begun to run from the date of the first publication of this statement. Copies of the full ordinance are available at no cost and during regular business hours, at the Clerk's office for members of the general public who request the same. The summary of the terms of such bond ordinance follows:

**Title:** BOND ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR VARIOUS IMPROVEMENTS TO THE BEAVERBROOK AREA IN THE BOROUGH OF BARRINGTON, IN THE COUNTY OF CAMDEN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY; APPROPRIATING \$1,100,000 THEREFOR AND AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF \$1,100,000 BONDS OR NOTES TO FINANCE PART OF THE COST THEREOF

**Purpose(s):** Various Improvements To The Beaverbrook Area Of The Borough Including, But Not Limited To, The Discharge Area At Shreve Avenue, The Removal And Reconstruction Of The Concrete Spillway, The Removal Of Debris And The Reconstruction/Stabilization Of Brooks Banks, Such Improvements Including, But Not Limited To, As Applicable, Milling, Paving, Reconstruction And Resurfacing Of The Roadway, The Repairing And/Or Installation Of Drainage Improvements, Landscaping And Aesthetic Improvements.
